nlike many other serviced apartments that seem to offer generic landscapes, Kush means serviced apartments with their own personalities, yet retaining the essence of being in Hong Kong by their culturally rich settings.

255 Des Voeux Road West is a contemporary tribute to old Chinese residential blocks, offering compact 550-squarefoot units.



To optimize space, all in-room amenities such as washing machines are hidden behind panels on the walls. Each unit also adopts a kitchen island concept that features a marble bar housing a cooking hub, while doubling as a perfect space for cocktails. Up on the roof is a golf driving range with ultimate privacy.

111 High Street offers a suburban feel with old colonial buildings on one side and harbor views on the other. Its 22 750-square-foot units provide a choice of one or two bedroom layouts. There is one unit with a terrace and one with access to a private rooftop.

The latest flagship building, 222 Hollywood Road, embodies the uniqueness of Hong Kong as a cultural mix. While surrounded by antique galleries and old Chinese temples, it is walking distance from Soho and the Central business district. Among the 48 one-bedroom apartments of 650 square feet, guests can choose between brown or black interiors, both fitted with open glass showers and adjustable mood lighting for a modern touch.

All Kush apartments come with hightech and hotel-style amenities, such as JBL sound system and Smeg washer and dryer. Kush Envy Card provides residents access to partner clubs, restaurants and
